Series of 2021

**ON THE ALLOWABLE ON-SITE OPERATIONAL OR VENUE/SEATING CAPACITY
OF BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS/ACTIVITIES**


Pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 134, Series of 2021, placing under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) the National Capital Region (NCR) and province of Laguna **from 21 to 31 August 2021**, and the province of Bataan **from 23 to 31 August 2021**, presented in Annex "A" are the business establishments/activities and their allowable on-site operational or venue/seating capacity, except for the following which shall still not be allowed to operate for the duration of the MECQ --

- a. Personal care services including beauty salons, beauty parlors, barbershops, and nail spas; and
- b. Indoor and al-fresco dine-in services of food preparation establishments such as commissaries, restaurants, and eateries.

Strict monitoring of compliance with minimum public health and safety standards and protocols under DOH Administrative Order No. 2020-0015, Series of 2020, DTI-DOLE JMC No. 2020-04-A, Series of 2020, DOLE Department Order No. 224-21, Series of 2021, and applicable sector-relevant guidelines, shall continue to be enforced.

Be guided accordingly.
