Passenger Airbag Inflator, as follows:



Inflator is affected by this recall. Chevrolet service centers across the country have been notified to inspect and repair all affected vehicles.

As mentioned, TCCCI, from the very start, has already notified its customer and the public to recall all **Passenger Airbag inflators** of the affected Suburban and Tahoe models.

In a letter dated 15 September 2021, TCCCI also informed this office of the said recall campaign. However, when TCCCI submitted the letter informing the department of TCCCI's recall campaign for the aforementioned vehicles, the letter was supposedly a recall campaign for TAKATA Passenger Airbag Inflator for certain 2007 to 2012 model years of Suburban and Tahoe, rather than TAKATA Driver's Airbag for the same models, as highlighted below. The afore-cited mistake was only thru the letter that was submitted to this office. In fact, notices of public recall campaigns as well as notices served to the customers were all TAKATA Passenger Airbag Inflator.

Dear Undersecretary Castelo.

Greetings.

In line with its corporate commitment to safety, General Motors Thailand (GMTh) and its domestics distributor in the Philippines, The Covenant Car Company, Inc. (TCCCI), has conducted a Preventive Safety Recall Campaign last year.

Accordingly. GMTh continuously conducts routine inspections of its vehicles, and in one of these inspections, it discovered that aside from the previous notice of recall campaign of Takata Airbags replacement dated April 29, 2019, received by the Office of the Undersecretary Consumer Protection Group, some of the TAKATA Driver's Airbag for certain 2007 2012 model years of Suburban and Tahoe (subject vehicles) which are made of non-desiccated Phased Stabilized Ammonium Nitrate (PSAN), as a propellant may over time degrade due to a combination of a high absolute humidity environment and high temperature for long term exposure.

Although no reports have been received by GMTh alleging injuries or damages related to this condition, this may after its performance and may cause the airbag to go off with too much force in case of a collision, that may cause sharp metal fragments to shoot out and cause injury.

In this regard, TCCCI, the authorized distributor of Chevrolet vehicles in the Philippines, would like to inform your good office that TCCCI, through its Chevrolet Customer Service Centers, shall conduct a Special Service Campaign for the TAKATA Driver's Airbags of the above-stated subject vehicles.

In this regard, TCCCI would like to manifest that the afore-cited mistake was not intentional and was not intended to mislead the stakeholders and this Honorable Office. We respectfully request this Office's indulgence and kind understanding, and respectfully beg to take notice of this letter.

Rest assured that TCCCI will continue to carry out the Special Service Campaign for TAKATA Passenger Airbag Inflator of the affected vehicles via its Chevrolet Customer Service Centers. TCCCI will repair the affected models and, if necessary, replace them with new TAKATA Passenger Airbag Inflators at NO COST to the customers.


