## Subject: High-Pressure Fuel Pump Recall

Dear Director Carbonell,

We respectfully write your good office to inform you on the above subject as we prioritize our customer's safety.

Honda Motor Co., Ltd. Japan have announced the recall of several Honda vehicles for the test and possible replacement of **High-Pressure Fuel Pump**. Relatively, Honda Cars Philippines, Inc. ("HCPI"), the authorized Honda Distributor in the Philippines will conduct a Recall Campaign for the following models:

Findings show that High-Pressure Fuel Pump may have cracks on its Core B which may result to gasoline leakage. The gasoline could be smelled while idling and driving.

While there have been no reported cases of Fuel Leak related to the subject matter in the Philippines, HCPI with our thirty-eight (38) authorized Honda Dealers and three (3) Service Centers nationwide will proceed with the Leak Testing of the High-

Pressure Fuel Pump. In case gasoline leak is detected, the High-Pressure Fuel Pump shall be replaced. This will be **Free of Charge** for the vehicle owners. For the Leak Test, it will only take Thirty Minutes (0.5hrs). In case of High-Pressure Fuel Pump replacement, it will take a maximum of Three Hours (3.0hrs) to replace.

We will duly notify the vehicle owners or will seek assistance and reach out with the new owners in case the vehicles have been sold or disposed already.
