Description

Invitation to Bid for Supply and Delivery of Sari-Sari Store Livelihood Kits for LSP-NSB of DTI Rizal Provincial Office (1 Lot)

1. The Department of Trade and Industry Region IV-A, through the General Appropriations Act FY 2022 intends to apply the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 1,500,000.00) being the ABC to payments under the contract for Supply and Delivery of Sari-Sari Store Livelihood Kits for LSP-NSB of DTI Rizal Provincial Office (1 Lot) (Bidding No.: 8687295). Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. The Department of Trade and Industry Region IV-A now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required to be completed within the indicated delivery schedule from receipt of Notice to Proceed and Purchase Order. Bidders should have completed, within three (3) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non- discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from Department of Trade and Industry Region IV-A and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during Monday to Friday except holidays, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on May 22, 2022 from the given

address and website(s) below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 1,500.00). The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees by presenting the hard copy or electronic copy of the official receipt.

6. The Department of Trade and Industry Region IV-A will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on May 30, 2022, 1:30 PM through video conferencing via Zoom, which shall be open to prospective bidders.

7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below, on or before June 13, 2022, 8:30 AM. Late bids shall not be accepted.

8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.

9. Bid opening shall be on June 13, 2022, 1:30 PM at the given address below and via Zoom video conferencing. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' authorized representatives who choose to attend the activity.

10. The Department of Trade and Industry Region IV-A reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Supply and Delivery of Sari-Sari Store Livelihood Kits for LSP-NSB of DTI Rizal Provincial Office (1 Lot)

I. Background

The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) being the government's arm in the promotion and development of Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), is committed to provide needed resources that will support the recovery and continuity of affected businesses and populace. As such, the DTI, together with other government agencies such as but not limited to the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), and Local Government Units (LGUs), and the National Task Force to End Local Armed Conflict (NTF-ELCAC), etc. needs to provide timely delivery of services to affected families, individuals, and businesses.

In pursuing the directive of President Duterte to help the country's base of the pyramid, DTI develops the Negosyo Serbisyo sa Barangay (NSB) Program. Republic Act No. 7160 also known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the role of barangays in attaining national development through serving as the primary planning and implementing unit of policies, plans, programs, projects, and activities in the community. The efforts of DTI and services of other government agencies could be extended to more Filipinos through the barangays.

The initiative is in support of the goals and aspirations of multilateral agreements at the regional and international levels. The NSB Program aligns well with the United Nation's 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development which sets out the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) intended to eradicate poverty and realize sustainable development in the next fifteen years. The development goals are geared towards achieving a better and more sustainable future. These consider inclusive economic growth as necessary strife in attaining sustainable jobs and promoting equality. The NSB further support the ASEAN Economic Community's (AEC) third pillar of integration, on equitable economic development wherein the progress of the MSMEs is considered as the key towards narrowing development gaps.

The Department's NSB Program lies within the purview of whole government approach wherein public agencies related to supporting inclusive business ecosystem work across portfolio boundaries and mandate to encourage entrepreneurial activities and integrated government assistance.

The DTI Department Order No. 21-99, series of 2021 aims to provide an individual package of livelihood kits amounting to not more than Fifteen Thousand Pesos (Php 15,000.00) to aid the qualified affected beneficiaries including those in Local Communist Armed Conflict (LCAC) affected areas, vulnerable communities such as the Indigenous Peoples (IPs), and refugees or stateless persons, also known as Persons of Concern (POCs), and those who have undergone the DTI Capacity Development Programs. The livelihood kit will help to restore and improve their business in

case of catastrophic events like natural and human-induced calamities including health disaster like epidemics and pandemics.

- Grocery items must be properly packed, sealed and labeled in storage boxes (except for 25 kgs. of rice). Please see Annex A for proper labeling (to be printed by External Provider).
- The External Provider is not allowed to put any markings or logo on storage boxes except for the required label in Annex A.
- The External Provider shall designate personnel to assist DTI during item inspection.
- The External Provider shall provide logistics support in loading and unloading of items to designated areas in each delivery location.
- In case of damaged item/s or deficiency in quantity, the External Provider shall supply the item/s within the day of delivery.



ABC – Approved Budget for the Contract.

BAC – Bids and Awards Committee.

Bid – A signed offer or proposal to undertake a contract submitted by a bidder in response to and in consonance with the requirements of the bidding documents. Also referred to as *Proposal* and *Tender*. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[c])

Bidder – Refers to a contractor, manufacturer, supplier, distributor and/or consultant who submits a bid in response to the requirements of the Bidding Documents. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[d])

Bidding Documents – The documents issued by the Procuring Entity as the bases for bids, furnishing all information necessary for a prospective bidder to prepare a bid for the Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and/or Consulting Services required by the Procuring Entity. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[e])

BIR – Bureau of Internal Revenue.

BSP – Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas.

Consulting Services – Refer to services for Infrastructure Projects and other types of projects or activities of the GOP requiring adequate external technical and professional expertise that are beyond the capability and/or capacity of the GOP to undertake such as, but not limited to: (i) advisory and review services; (ii) pre-investment or feasibility studies; (iii) design; (iv) construction supervision; (v) management and related services; and (vi) other technical services or special studies. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[i])

CDA - Cooperative Development Authority.

Section II. Instructions to Bidders

1. Scope of Bid

The Procuring Entity, *Department of Trade and Industry Region IV-A* wishes to receive Bids for the *Supply and Delivery of Sari-Sari Store Livelihood Kits for LSP-NSB of DTI Rizal Provincial Office (1 Lot)*, with identification number *2022-05-03*.

2. Funding Information

2.1. The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for *2022* in the amount of *One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 1,500,000.00)*.

2.2. The source of funding is:

NGA, the General Appropriations Act of 2022.

3. Bidding Requirements

The Bidding for the Project shall be governed by all the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including its Generic Procurement Manuals and associated policies, rules and regulations as the primary source thereof, while the herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source thereof.

Any amendments made to the IRR and other GPPB issuances shall be applicable only to the ongoing posting, advertisement, or **IB** by the BAC through the issuance of a supplemental or bid bulletin.

The Bidder, by the act of submitting its Bid, shall be deemed to have verified and accepted the general requirements of this Project, including other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract, project, or work and examine all instructions, forms, terms, and project requirements in the Bidding Documents.

4. Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, and Coercive Practices

5. Eligible Bidders

- 5.1. Only Bids of Bidders found to be legally, technically, and financially capable will be evaluated.
- 5.2. Foreign ownership exceeding those allowed under the rules may participate pursuant to:
 - i. When a Treaty or International or Executive Agreement as provided in Section 4 of the RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR allow foreign bidders to participate;

7. Subcontracts

- 7.1. The Bidder may subcontract portions of the Project to the extent allowed by the Procuring Entity as stated herein, but in no case more than twenty percent (20%) of the Project.

- 7.2. Subcontracting of any portion of the Project does not relieve the Supplier of any liability or obligation under the Contract. The Supplier will be responsible for the acts, defaults, and negligence of any subcontractor, its agents, servants, or workmen as fully as if these were the Supplier's own acts, defaults, or negligence, or those of its agents, servants, or workmen.

8. Pre-Bid Conference

The Procuring Entity will hold a pre-bid conference for this Project on the specified date and time and either at its physical address and/or through video conferencing as indicated in paragraph 6 of the **IB**.

9. Clarification and Amendment of Bidding Documents

Prospective bidders may request for clarification on and/or interpretation of any part of the Bidding Documents. Such requests must be in writing and received by the Procuring Entity, either at its given address or through electronic mail indicated in the **IB**, at least ten (10) calendar days before the deadline set for the submission and receipt of Bids.

10. Documents comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components

- 10.1. The first envelope shall contain the eligibility and technical documents of the Bid as specified in **Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents)**.
- 10.2. The Bidder's SLCC as indicated in **ITB** Clause 5.3 should have been completed within *three (3) years* prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.
- 10.3. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. Similar to the required authentication above, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.

11. Documents comprising the Bid: Financial Component

- 11.1. The second bid envelope shall contain the financial documents for the Bid as specified in **Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents)**.
- 11.2. If the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder or Domestic Entity, a certification issued by DTI shall be provided by the Bidder in accordance with Section 43.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 11.3. Any bid exceeding the ABC indicated in paragraph 1 of the **IB** shall not be

accepted.

- 11.4. For Foreign-funded Procurement, a ceiling may be applied to bid prices provided the conditions are met under Section 31.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

12. Bid Prices

- 12.1. Prices indicated on the Price Schedule shall be entered separately in the following manner:

- a. For Goods offered from within the Procuring Entity's country:
 - i. The price of the Goods quoted EXW (ex-works, ex-factory, ex-warehouse, ex-showroom, or off-the-shelf, as applicable);
 - ii. The cost of all customs duties and sales and other taxes already paid or payable;
 - iii. The cost of transportation, insurance, and other costs incidental to delivery of the Goods to their final destination; and
 - iv. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, listed in e.
- b. For Goods offered from abroad:
 - i. Unless otherwise stated in the **BDS**, the price of the Goods shall be quoted delivered duty paid (DDP) with the place of destination in the Philippines as specified in the **BDS**. Section IV. General Conditions of Contract
