The EMC shall assist in the search for Dubai Buyers and help in the match-making process as well.

But later from page 12 on, it talked about 4 MONTH services but without much detail breakdown (except for Manpower which we saw it is on the Annexes) 	 Period covered by the 4 month services is from 1 September to 31 December 2021. Winning Bidder to provide the following services as indicated in the Terms of Reference (TOR)—see pages 13- 16 for details: Manpower –As indicated in Bid Bulletin # 1 we reduced the number of manpower required from nine (9) to six (6) usherettes from 1 September to 31 December 2021 plus a week after Dec. 31 for debriefing purposes Catering services for a maximum of 90 pax or 3 groups of 10 pax each per month for the period covering (1 October 2021 to 31 December 2021).
