

The country's headline inflation continues to slow down with 1.8 percent this March 2025 from 2.1 from the previous month. This brings the national average inflation for the year to 2.3 percent. The headline inflation for the month is also slower compared to the 3.7 percent in March 2024. The main contributors to the headline inflation for March 2025 include the slower annual increment in the index of food and non-alcoholic beverages at 2.2 percent from 2.6 percent in the previous month; a faster year-on-year decrease in the transport index at 1.1 percent during the month from 0.2 percent in February 2025;

and a slower inflation rate for restaurants and accommodation services at 2.3 percent from 2.8 percent in the previous month.
