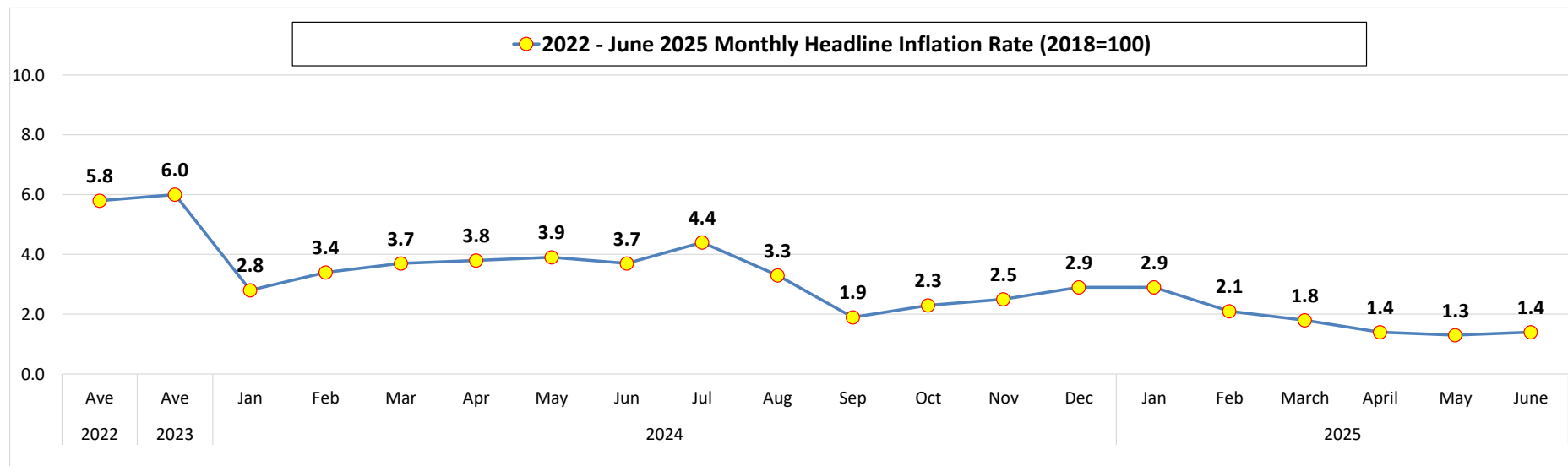

The country's headline inflation increased to 1.4 percent this June 2025 from 1.3 in the previous month. This brings the national average inflation for 2025 to 1.8 percent. The headline inflation for the month is lower compared to the inflation rate for June 2024 at 3.7 percent. The main contributors to the headline inflation for June 2025 include the higher year-on-year increase in the index of housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels at 3.2 percent from 2.3 percent in the previous month, and the slower annual decrease in the index of transport at 1.6 percent from the previous 2.4 percent.
