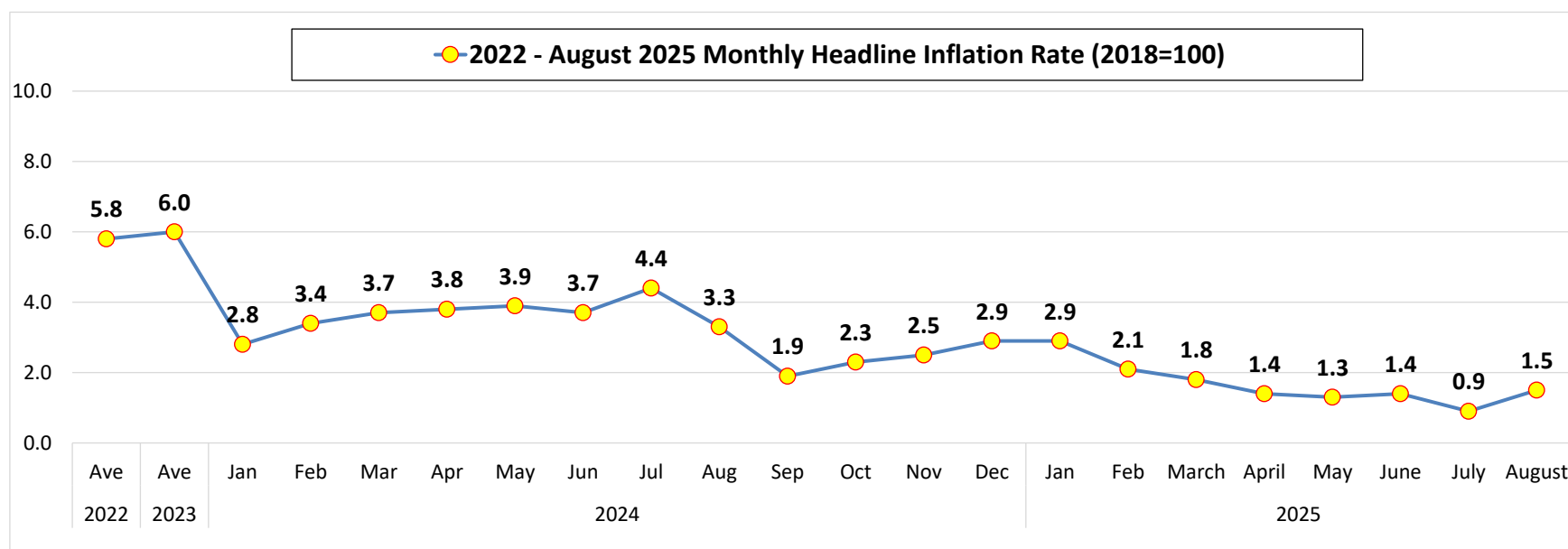

The country's headline inflation increased to 1.5 percent this August 2025 from 0.9 percent in the previous month. This brings the national average inflation for 2025 to 1.7 percent. The headline inflation for the month is lower compared to the inflation rate for August 2024 at 3.3 percent. The main contributors to the headline inflation for August 2025 include the annual increase in the index of food and non-alcoholic beverages at 0.9 percent from an annual decline of 0.2 percent in the previous month, and
