

**ADVISORY NO. 21- 11
Series of 2021**

**ON THE ALLOWABLE ON-SITE OPERATIONAL OR VENUE/SEATING CAPACITY
OF CERTAIN BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AND ACTIVITIES
IN NCR and BULACAN VIS-A-VIS LAGUNA, CAVITE, and RIZAL**

Pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 121, Series of 2021, in consideration of the rise and fall in the number of COVID-19 cases, overall healthcare utilization rate, and capability to cope with projected increases in COVID-19 cases, the following are the on-site operational or venue/seating capacity from **16 June 2021 to 30 June 2021** for the respective jurisdictions:

¹ **Essential Meetings** refer to a congregation of at least two (2) people, with or without external participants, vital to the sustenance of the operations and business interests of the organization and not for recreational or leisure purposes, such as workshops, trainings, seminars, congresses, conferences, conventions, board meetings, colloquia, conclaves, symposia, company/government recognitions, and press conferences (DOT-DTI JMC No. 2021-001, Series of 2021)

² **Social Events** refer to private gatherings to celebrate special occasions such as, but not limited to, wedding ceremonies and receptions, engagement parties, wedding anniversaries, debut and birthday parties, family reunions, and bridal or baby showers. (DOT-DTI JMC No. 2021-001, Series of 2021)

Business establishments awarded Safety Seal Certifications (DOLE-DOH-DILG-DOT-DTI Joint Memorandum Circular No. 21-01, Series of 2021) shall be allowed to operate at an **additional ten percentage points** beyond the prescribed on-site operational or venue/seating capacity, whichever is applicable, regardless of community quarantine classification.

Attached as Annex "A" is the updated list of business establishments and their prescribed on-site operational or venue capacity.

Compliance with minimum public health and safety standards and protocols under DOH Administrative Order No. 2020-0015, Series of 2020, DTI-DOLE JMC No. 2020-04-A, Series of 2020, DOLE Department Order No. 224-21, Series of 2021, and applicable sector-relevant guidelines shall continue to be strictly enforced.

³ "Non-contact sports venues" shall refer to business establishments catering to sports or activities in which participants are physically separated throughout its duration, thus, minimizing the possibility of making any form of purposeful or accidental physical contact.
