2024 PRESIDENTIAL AWARDS FOR OUTSTANDING MSMES

A program to recognize MSMEs whose outstanding efforts have enabled them to meet challenging standards of excellence and showed consistently their commitment for growth, competitiveness, innovation and sustainability in the country.

AWARD CATEGORIES

- Outstanding Small Enterprise Category One (1) awardee to be selected from among the Outstanding Small Enterprise winners from the Island groups of Northern Luzon, Southern Luzon (including NCR), Visayas, and Mindanao.
- Outstanding Medium Enterprise Category One (1) awardee to be selected from among the Cutstanding Medium Enterprise winners. There shall be one Outstanding Medium Enterprise winner from each island group.

CRITERIA

- Nominee must have an asset size of PhP3,000,001 up to PhP15,000,000 for the Small Enterprise Category and PhP15,000,001 up to PhP100,000,000 for the Medium Enterprise Category at the time of nomination.
- Nominee can be a manufacturing, agri-business, trading (wholesale or retail), services (e.g., BPOs, hospitality, creative industry, etc.) entity, or enterprise as defined in the Magna Carta for MSMEs.
- Nominee can be a sole proprietorship, cooperative, association, partnership, or corporation.
 Nominee must be 100% Filipin-owned and duly registered with appropriate government agencies.
 The nominee must be upon in operation for at least three (3) veers and has shown conflictibility for
- the last two (2) years at the time of nomination.

 Previous recipients of any Presidential Awards (at the time of nomination) may no longer be

NOMINATIONS

Who may nominate

- Government agencies and private organizations (provincial chapters of industry associations, chambers of commerce and industry, business organizations e.g. cooperatives, financial service provides etc., and one consensus or programment and the provincial level may compliate the Michael
- providers, etc., and non-government organizations) at the provincial level may nominate the MSME beneficiaries of their current programs and services ("Nominating Agencies.") Setf-nominations by MSMEs are after unknown.

Where to submit nominations

Nomination Forms and supporting documents must be submitted by the Nominating Agency, or the MSME if self-nominated, to the Provincial MSMED Council (PMSMED Council) through the concerned DTI-Provincial Office by 8 March 2024.

An initiative of the MSME Development Council which aims to recognize and cite programs and services that best serve the MSME sector and promote MSME programs and services.

RECOGNITION CATEGORIES

Outstanding development partners (government and private) implementing programs under the following categories shall be recognized:

- Creating/ Improving Business Climate (BC)
 Providing/ Improving Access to Finance (A2F)
 Providing/ Improving Access to Markets (A2M)
- Providing/ Improving Access to Markets (A2M)
 Providing/ Improving Access to Technology and Innovation (T&I)
 - Enhancing Management and Labor Capacities (MLC)

CRITERIA

- The development partner's program must fall under any of the following categories: BC, A2F, A2M, T3I, and MLC.
 The program must have been in existence for at least one (1) year.
- The program must have verifiable and significant results, self sustaining and has the potential for expansion/replication.
- Previous recipients of any Presidential Awards/Citations (at the time of nomination) may no longer be nominated.

NOMINATIONS

Who may nominate:

- Government agencies and private organizations (e.g. industry associations, chambers of
- commerce and industry, business organizations, non-government organizations, cooperatives) may nominate their partner agencies implementing programs on MSME development. MSMIs may nominate occement agencies and/or provide institutions for programs they have
 - significantly benefited from.

 Self-nomination may be accepted
