

CHECKLIST

Use this list to check that you have met the requirements of the Act.

The Safeguard Measures Act of the Philippines requires that a properly documented application include the following information where it is reasonably available:

- The names of the Philippine producers making the application;
- The names of all known Philippine producers of like or directly competitive products;
- A description of the volume and value of the domestic production of the like or directly competitive products both by the producers making the application and all other known Philippine producers;
- A complete description of the imported products and the like or directly competitive product by Philippine producers;
- The names of the countries of export of the imported products;
- The names of each known foreign producer or exporter of the imported products;
- The names of persons known to be importing the product under consideration;
- The volume and value of imports into the Philippines of the products under consideration;
- The effects that the imports of the products under consideration have had, or will have, on the market share of like or directly competitive products in the Philippines;
- The consequent economic impact of those imports on the Philippine industry;
- Relevant factors affecting the industry that may have a bearing on the information required under the last two items above;
- When applicable, evidences to support the existence of critical circumstances and a statement on the extent to which the imposition of provisional measures will help to improve the industry's' present condition;
- Statement on the form and duration of the safeguard measures sought;
- Statement of the adjustment plan of the domestic industry to increase competitiveness or adapt to new conditions of competition.
