

Starting a Business

Herbal soap contains natural ingredients like essential oils, juice or extract, and vitamins from medicinal plants.

Preparation of a Decoction: (Akapulko and Guava Soap)

- Wash the leaves thoroughly and chop or cut in small pieces.
- Measure 1 glass of chopped fresh leaves and 2 glasses of water.
- Let it boil for 15 minutes (start timing when the water starts to boil).
- Remove from fire and strain the leaves in a cheese cloth. Set aside and let it cool.

II. PROCEDURES

- Measure 1 glass of caustic soda and 3 glasses of Akapulko or Guava decoction and pour into a plastic pail.
- Mix well by stirring continuously using a wooden ladle or bamboo stick. Use only one direction when stirring.
- 3. Stir until the caustic soda is dissolved.
- 4. Pour cooking oil into the mixture.
- Continue stirring until a consistency similar to a condensed milk is achieved.
- 6. Pour the soap mixture into desired plastic molders. Set aside and let it cool to harden.
- 7. After 4-5 hours, remove the soap from the molder.
- 8. Allow 30 days of ageing before packing.
- 9. Label the soaps.
